Under the direction of the Laboratory Manager or Chief Medical Technologist, the Clinical Laboratory Scientist is responsible for providing clinical laboratory services to patients in accordance with accepted practices and Departmental and Hospital standards of care.

- Performs clinical laboratory procedures in chemistry, hematology, immunohematology, blood banking, microbiology and clinical microscopy.
- Assists in data collection for statistical surveys or other reports generated by the department; participates in performance improvement activities within the department.
- Utilizes specialized knowledge of clinical laboratory principles in the maintenance of instrumentations, documentation of QC programs, patient results' reporting and in the performance of general duties.
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Chief Medical Technologist/Lab Manager.
